The Australian market commences Tuesday's trade with an ASX rebound on the back of a positive European market performance overnight.

US equities were closed yesterday, as Juneteenth Holiday was observed.

Locally, RBA Minutes of the June 2022 Monetary Policy Meeting of the Reserve Bank Board release today at 11:30am AEST.

Regionally, United States release the Chicago Fed National Activity Index for May 2022 at 10:30pm AEST tonight, which increased to 0.47 points in April 2022 from a 3-month low of 0.36 points in March 2022. Also from the US, Existing Home Sales reports for May 2022 to be released tomorrow 12:00am AEST, with last month's sales declining by 2.4%.

In overnight commodities trade, **brent crude** settle higher at \$114.13.

US gold futures down 0.04% to \$US1839.9/oz.

Iron ore (Nymex CFR China, 62% Fe) down at \$US128/t.

LME (3mth evening) **copper, aluminium** settled lower and **nickel** turned higher.

Commodities Commentary

Oil – by keeping a tight hold on oil supplies and current sanctions on Russian oil supply in place, analysts and investors believe ICE Brent should hold around the \$US120 mark.

Meanwhile, China's oil imports from Russia have soared 55% YoY. Libya's oil production as remained volatile, with its recent output reported at 700,000bpd.

Strategic release of oil reserves in the US have allowed some mitigation for tight supply.

 ${\it Gold}$ – The gold market is holding firm in a relatively neutral territory, trading in a narrow range between \$1,800/oz and \$1,850/oz.
